
## How to assign my match tickets?

This guide explains how to assign your tickets.


Step 1: Go to the RBFA ticketing platform


Log in via the red button at the top right.




Step 2: Log in with the RBFA account you used to purchase your tickets



**Step 3:** At the top right, click on your name and select **My tickets**.



Step 4: Click on 'Assign ticket'



Step 5: Now assign your tickets to the correct person

Choose whether you will use the ticket yourself or assign it to someone else.

## **5A) TICKET FOR YOURSELF**

If you want to attend the match yourself, choose "**keep**". You can now use your ticket to access the stadium.


## **5B) TICKET FOR SOMEONE ELSE**

If you want to assign the ticket to someone else, enter that person's email address, first name, and last name. They will receive a confirmation by email and can accept or

decline the ticket. If they accept the ticket, it will also appear in their profile under "My tickets".

**IMPORTANT:** This person must have an RBFA account. If the person you want to assign the ticket to doesn't have an account yet, they will need to create one via: <a href="https://extranet.e-kickoff.com/ast/faces/registration">https://extranet.e-kickoff.com/ast/faces/registration</a>

**BE AWARE**: a ticket in the "Member 1895", "Member 1895 U12", or "U12" price category can only be assigned to people whose profile matches this category, meaning a person who is a member or under 12 years old.



## Step 6: Add my friends & family (optional)

If you want to avoid entering the name and email address of your companions for each match, you can also add them to your "My friends & family" list. This way, for a future match, you can simply select the name without having to fill in all the information again.
